


## PC-1200 FG DEFOAMER

This chemical is not considered hazardous by the 2012 OSHA Hazard Communication Standard (29 CFR 1910.1200). Not a dangerous substance or mixture according to the Globally Harmonized System (GHS).

**Recommended First Aid: IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention. **IF ON SKIN (or hair):** Wash off immediately with soap and plenty of water while removing all contaminated clothes and shoes. Wash contaminated clothing and shoes before reuse. Get medical attention if irritation develops and persists. **IF SWALLOWED:** Do NOT induce vomiting. Drink plenty of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a doctor if you feel unwell. **IF INHALED:** Remove to fresh air. Immediate medical attention is not required. Consult a physician if necessary.

**Storage:** Do not store near heat. Freezing will not change the performance of PC-1200 but may cause difficulty in handling due to high viscosity. It is recommended that PC-1200 be used within 2 years of manufacture. Beyond 2 years, the product should be tested prior to use.

## SILICONE DEFOAMER

PC-1200 FG Defoamer is a 100% silicone and its components are in compliance with FDA regulation 21 CFR 173.340 (a)(2). Consult this regulation for usage limitations. PC-1200 is not permitted in milk.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** PC-1200 is permitted in foods at a maximum of 10 ppm in most cases. It may be effective at much lower concentrations. Start with 10 ppm and reduce antifoam levels until you reach your optimal level of foam control.
